Michelle den Dekker's exceptional agility and leadership have been inspirational both on and off the court, and her contributions to netball and the profile of women in Australian sport have been outstanding.

Michelle made her Australian Netball debut in 1985 and went on to play 84 test matches in the green and gold, captaining Australia from 1988-1995.

Michelle won two World Championships as captain and led Australia to a Commonwealth Gold medal in 1990.

Michelle was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia (OAM) in 1992 and awarded the SA Great Award for services to sport in South Australia in 1993.

Michelle continues to contribute to sport by delivering coaching education to clubs and schools through Australia and as an Ambassador for the Childhood Cancer Association.

Michelle became an ambassador shortly after her son Jakeb was diagnosed with Hodgkin's Lymphoma in 2013. Jake is currently in remission.

In July this year Michelle will participate in the Glasgow Commonwealth Games as the Diamonds Assistant Coach looking for that elusive Gold Medal for Australia!

**LEGENDARY NATIONAL BASKETBALL**

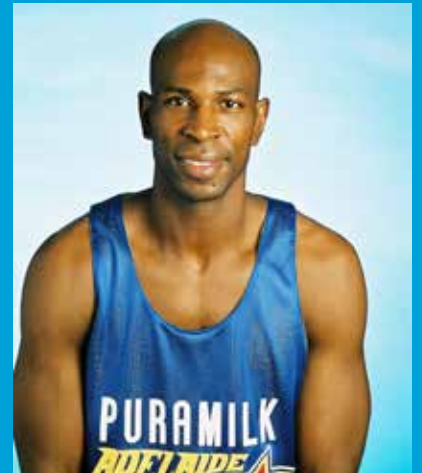

# WELCOME TO THE 2018 MURRAY BRIDGE GREEN SOUTH AUSTRALIAN MASTERS GAMES

The Rural City of Murray Bridge is delighted to be hosting the 23rd annual South Australian Masters Games. Our community looks forward to warmly welcoming competitors, and their accompanying family and friends, from around Australia and overseas to our proud regional city.

This event will celebrate the 23rd staging of the South Australian Masters Games, with previous host regions including Ceduna, Clare, Mt. Gambier, Orroroo, Pt. Lincoln, Pt. Pirie, the Riverland and Whyalla. The 2018 South Australian Masters Games will be held from Thursday the 19th through to Sunday 22nd of April 2018.

## The Games

The Masters Games is a multi-sport event designed to allow sports people opportunities to participate in the sports of their choice and to compete with their age peers. The opportunity to participate, compete and to be physically active is the main motivation of the participants and while winning is important, it should not dominate the event. Social interaction is also a very important feature of Masters Games for the participants.

## The History

The Masters Games concept was first suggested by the Australian Sports Commission in the early 1980's. It was a concept that saw the beginnings of the World Masters appearing in Toronto in 1985 as well as the Alice Springs Masters in 1986. Since then a myriad of Masters events have supplied the world's mature age athletes with a host of opportunities in sharing a common philosophy of engaging in some form of activity and mixing it with a social occasion that will long be remembered. The South Australian Masters Games have been held annually since 1996 with a wide variety of regions hosting the Games.

## The Objectives of Masters Games are to:

- provide an incentive for athletes to renew, maintain or commence their active participation in sport
- supply a focus for sporting organisations to identify and recognise mature age participants, establish communication and encourage involvement in mainstream sport
- encourage sporting organisations to address the development of mature aged component of their sport
- stimulate and promote community interest and participation in sport
- encourage the partnership of Tourism and Sport in regional areas
- promote more people to participate in mature age sports activities from your region and the rest of South Australia
- provide an annual State Masters opportunity
- encourage retail and commerce to support the local development of sport in their region.

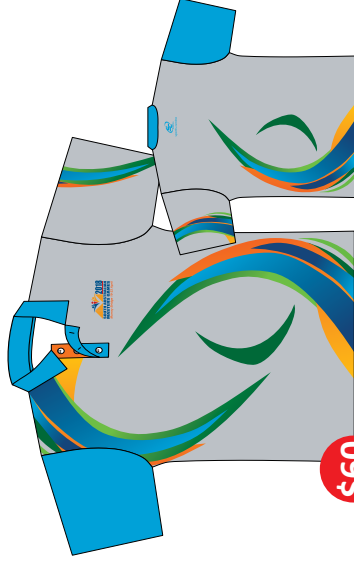

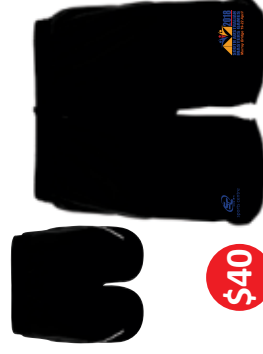

# ENTRY INFORMATION

**CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES** 5pm 1 March 2018.  
Late entries may be accepted by some sports but will incur a \$15 late games entry fee per person.

**ENTRY FORMS** Participants must complete;

1. Masters games registration with payment
2. Sports registration

Team organiser must also complete the team entry form.

**ENTRY FEE \$44** (GST inclusive) Compulsory entry fee covers administration, event management, medals, certificate and souvenir bags. Late entry fee of \$15.00 applies from 2 March 2018.

**SPORTS LEVY** Sports levies are set by the individual sports and vary from sport to sport.

**TEAM SPORTS** Each team organiser must complete the team entry form and each team member must complete the games entry form.

**AGE LIMIT** Competitors must turn the minimum age for their chosen sport by 31 December 2017. The minimum age for competitors varies from sport to sport. Proof of age will be required at games registration centre by all competitors by means of photo ID.

**INSURANCE** It is recommended that all competitors secure and are covered by personal medical insurance, or have secured and are covered by appropriate health cover prior to competing in the games.  
Some sports may require additional insurance specific to their sport. See individual sports for more information.

**ACCOMPANYING PERSONS/NON PLAYING OFFICIALS** Accompanying persons/non playing officials may pay their games entry fee of \$44 to receive all benefits available to competing athletes. However, medals will not be awarded.

**REFUND POLICY** A refund, less \$15 administration fee, will be given up to and including 1 March 2018. Refunds after the closing date will be sent at the discretion of the Organising Committee. All requests for refunds must be in writing.

**GAMES SCHEDULE** The sports coordinators reserve the right to cancel or vary the length and type of competition if numbers do not allow the original program to be followed.

## Registration Centre

All registered participants of the 2018 Masters Games must register in person with photo ID at the Registration Centre at the Murray Bridge Green Shopping Centre. No one may participate in any event without officially registering BEFORE commencing their sport.

Here, all participants will receive their official registration, sign the games waiver form, show proof of age and collect their participant bag and information. Any last minute changes to any event that may concern them will be made available to participants at that time. All individuals from sports teams need to attend the registration expo in person unless prior arrangements have been made via email no later than 24 hours prior to the start of the Opening Ceremony. Proof of identification will still need to be shown by the person registering on your behalf.

For all lost property please report to the registration centre at the Murray Bridge Green Shopping Centre. Lost property will be held for 2 weeks after the conclusion of the games. All property not claimed by then will be donated to local charities.

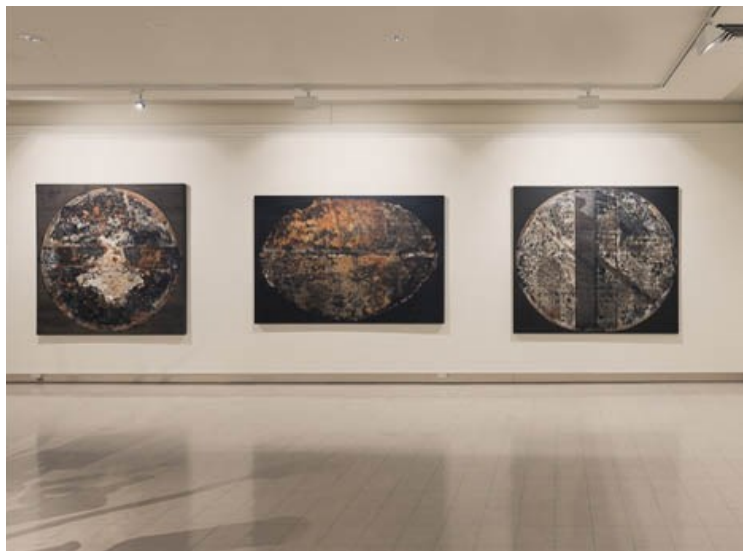

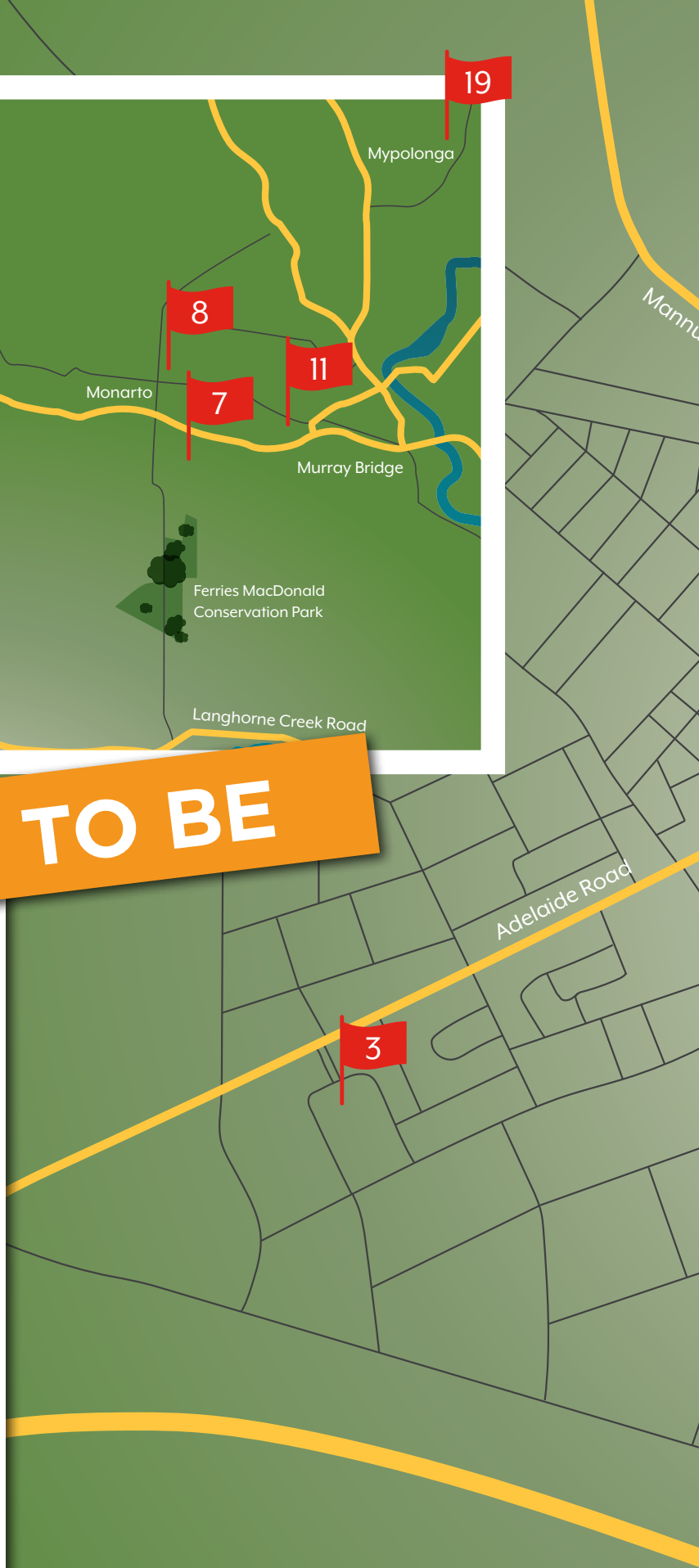

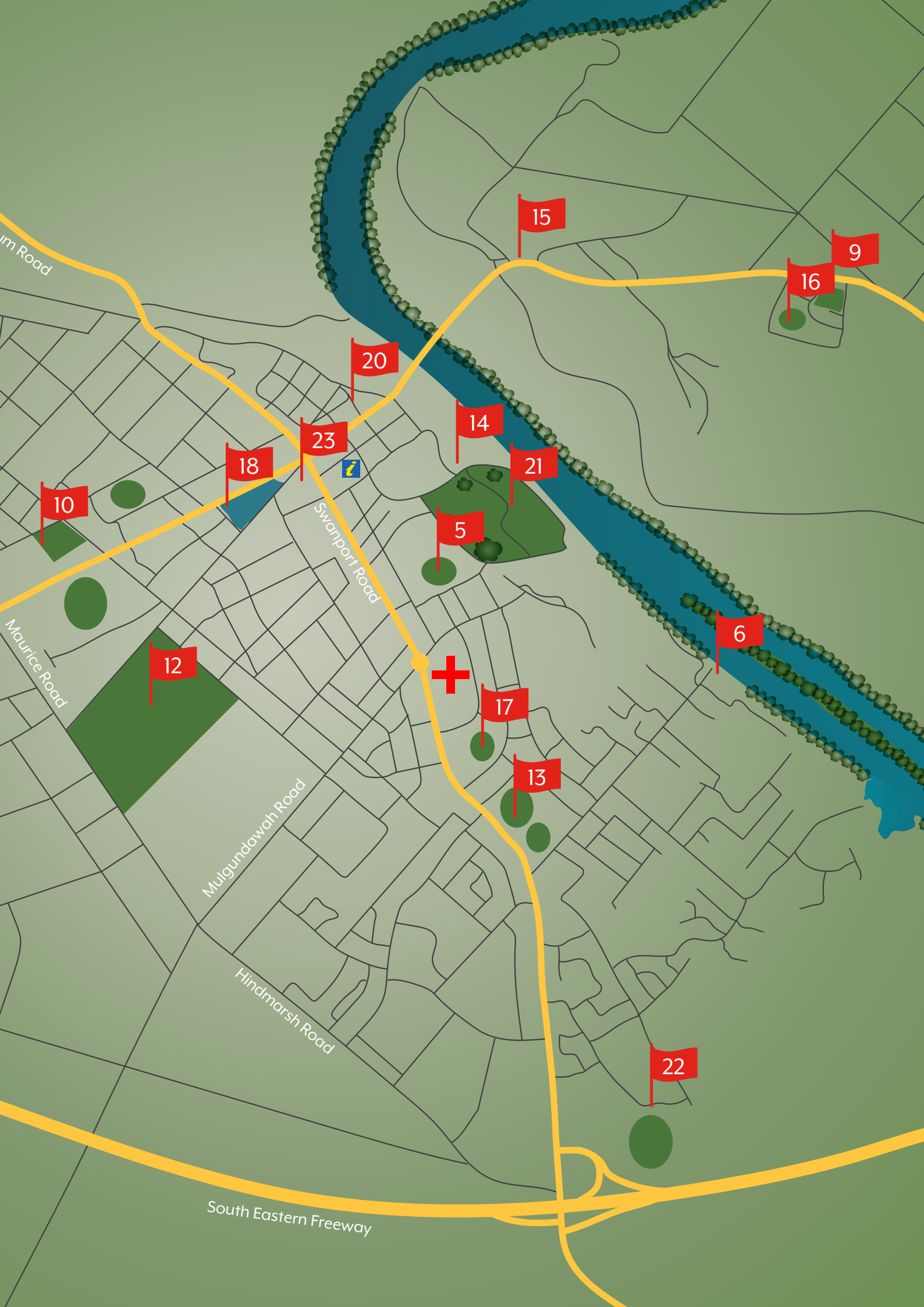
